Total Charges (not including the refundable Ground Deposit): £0

This must be paid prior to your event.

Any keys that need to be collected will be available at Eastfield House, Latham Road, Huntingdon, Cambs, PE29 6YG

Please remember:

- The overall safety of your staff, volunteers, participants and the public remain your responsibility. Huntingdonshire District Council cannot be held liable for any omissions or mistakes in the paperwork you have submitted to us.
- The security of the site is your responsibility so you must ensure access gates are monitored
 or locked at all times. If unauthorised vehicles access the site you are responsible for any
 costs incurred in removing them.
- Do not replace our padlock as our colleagues may need access to the site. If you wish to
 ensure a number of people have key access then you can put your own padlock adjacent to
 ours.
- If HDC bins become full during your event, **you are responsible for emptying them**. The outer cover unscrews upwards. You will need to ensure you have suitable bin bags. Do not leave them overflowing during, or after, your event. All rubbish must be removed from the site as soon as possible to prevent vermin spreading it.

• If there is damage to the site, or litter/rubbish we have to clear up, then we may need to keep your refundable deposit. We would liaise with you over this.
